

# BEAUTIFUL SUZUKI

Mask Tutorial



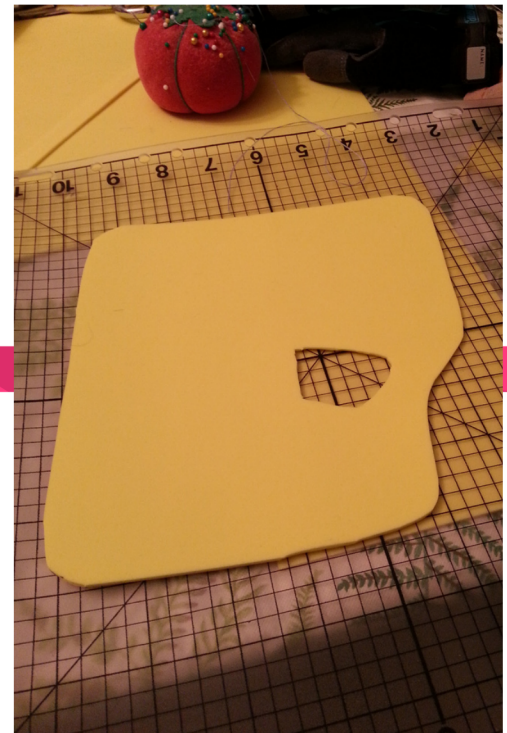
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## Mask Tutorial

01

### Materials:

- Craft foam, Worbla
- Heat gun or hairdryer
- Acrylic & 3D fabric paint
- Tacky glue

### Pattern:

Hold up the craft foam to the face and draw the outline, tracing around the nose and eye. Cut out the pattern piece.

### Cut Worbla:

Trace the foam pattern piece on the Worbla, treating the shiny/sticky side as the OUTSIDE of the mask. The shiny side is very smooth, so you won't need to use any fillers before priming and painting.

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### Heat Worbla:

Heat the Worbla SLIGHTLY with a hairdryer, just enough for it to bend. Worbla should be WARM, not HOT.

### Shape Worbla:

Gently place mask against your face to shape the contours of the nose, cheekbones, brow, and to wrap around the face.

### Add rivets:

Using 3D fabric paint with a drop-bottle applicator, apply small drops along the bottom and nose-side edge.

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### Glue Foam:

Glue the foam pattern onto the back of the Worbla mask to form the padding. Tape in place and let dry.

### Paint

Because the outside of the mask is using the shiny side of the Worbla, no gesso or fillers are needed. Prime and paint with your favorite acrylic paints!

### Folk Art Paint Formula:

- Prime: Black
- Base: Gunmetal + black
- Layer: Gunmetal
- Dry-brush: Sterling silver
- Highlight: Silver anniversary
